RULES AND CONDITIONS OF FESTIVAL

- 1. General and special rules and conditions as printed in the Schedule are valid for and continue for the period of the entire festival.
- 2. Competitors and Teachers will be regarded as being conversant with the rules of the Festival. The plea of lack of knowledge of the rules will not be accepted as a bona-fide reason for the infringement of any rule.
- 3. The Committee reserves the following rights -
 - to interpret these rules.
 - to decide any questions not contained in these rules.
 - to refuse any entries.
 - to ask any competitors to provide 'proof of age'.
 - to appoint substitute adjudicators.
 - to amend the programme at any time.
 - to exercise its discretion with regard to retention or cancellation of items.
 - to divide items where there are excessive numbers.
 - to combine age groups where there are insufficient entries.
- 4. Decisions of the Committee are final and binding on all matters.
- 5. No refunds will be given for change of mind or withdrawal (part payment or otherwise)
- 6. The Committee **WILL NOT** be responsible for "Copyright" payments where applicable. Payments are the responsibility of teachers and competitors.
- 7. The Adjudicator's decision is final.
- 8. The Adjudicator reserves the right to terminate any performances. This, however, **DOES NOT** necessarily mean disqualification or disapproval.
- 9. Decisions to withhold prizes will be at the discretion of the Adjudicator, with the concurrence of the Committee.
- 10. Communication with the Adjudicator during the competition by competitors, teachers, parents, guardians or other interested parties IS FORBIDDEN.
- 11. ICTDF is open to amateurs only. Amateurs being persons who do not earn the major portion of their income from the practice of dancing. No fulltime studios are allowed to enter.
- 12. Any false information provided to ICTDF will result in immediate disqualification, upon investigation.
- 13. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and his/her eligibility to appear in any age grouping, the Committee reserves the right to require the production of a birth certificate or formal form of proof of age from that competitor.
- 14. Bullying, including inappropriate comments or actions will NOT be tolerated by ICTDF and will result in instant disqualification, and/or the patron being removed from the Festival, upon investigation. The Convenors reserve the right to baby any person/s from the Festival and any future Festivals if deemed necessary.
- 15. In addition to ticking the 'Checked' box upon registration (which agrees to our T&C's as outlined in the Syllabus), a completed entry and payment will also confirm that you have agreed to all T&C's made by ICTDF.
- 16. Competitors appear in all sections entirely at their own risk.
- 17. Competitors who have had professional contact with the Adjudicator within the past twelve months **ARE NOT** eligible to enter this Festival.

- 18. Competitors are to report to the Backstage Manager before the commencement of items.
- 19. Competitors who deliberately display bad sportsmanship and so distress fellow competitors may be liable for disqualification
- 20. Competitors **ARE NOT** to wear uncovered tap shoes in the hall.
- 21. Competitors can appear **TWICE ONLY** in group items and must have 'taps' attached to their shoes in all items where tapping is performed. Failure to do this will mean disqualification. Back-Stage personnel have the authority to inspect all shoes.
- 22. Each Competitor competing needs a Competitor Pass
- 23. Each Studio/School receives 2 free Teacher's Passes and additional Teacher's Passes can be purchased.
- 24. DANCING SCHOOLS MUST USE THE ALLOTTED DRESSING ROOMS FOR GROUP SECTIONS.
- 25. There are to be NO photos or video taken INSIDE the dressing rooms. This space is for changing. Please take photos in front of the Media Wall or elsewhere.
- 26. Males over the age of nine (9) **ARE NOT** permitted in the female dressing rooms. Persons requiring special consideration regarding dressing rooms are asked to contact the Convenor.
- 27. Routines **ARE NOT** allowed to be repeated. Changes of music and/or costume **DO NOT** constitute changes in routines.
- 28. Vocal backing **WILL DEFINITELY NOT** be permitted in the vocal portion of Song and Dance items.
- 29. Time limits, which include entries and exits, are "maximum time limits". Items can be shorter than those quoted, but **MUST NOT EXCEED THEM**, this could incur deduction of points.
- 30. The use of electrical contact wires, or the lighting of matches on the stage for effect purposes such as **SMOKE**, **FOG OR SAND**, **IS NOT** permitted. Water or any other article or matter, which could cause bodily harm via any medium, **IS NOT** permitted on stage.
- 31. Mobile phones and pagers **MUST** be switched off before entering the hall
- 32. Musical Theatre Section Rules:
 - 5 minutes maximum;
 - Performance from recognised Musical Theatre show e.g. 42nd Street;
 - Can include singing, acting/dialogue & dance/movement;
 - Any dance style is acceptable;
 - No miming all vocals must be live;
 - Should visually/stylistically represent the show from which it comes;
 - Medleys are acceptable if they are from the same Musical Theatre show;
 - No Spoken or sung vocals on the track at all.
- 33. All competitors in Song and Dance groups must participate in BOTH SONG AND DANCE sections of the group.
- 34. Sections can be merged/combined at the Convenors discretion if entries are low.
- 35. **DEFINITELY** no video or still photography permitted. DANCEVISON.TV will provide professional photography and videos.
- 36. It is the Teacher's responsibility to report to the Backstage Manager and have the group ready side stage.

- 37. Teachers or Assistant Teachers only to collect Certificates and Badges from the back table.
- 38. **Restricted Groups are for Dance Studios who have not placed 1st in that genre at any competition. (This does not include a new dance in that genre**). These items are designed for smaller and /less competitive dance schools. The committee would appreciate if entering these items, it is done so in fairness to other entrants. Please contact a Convenor for any clarification.
- 39. **All Abilities** is a section designed for dancers with support needs or additional needs. ICTDF believes that dance should be an inclusive and welcoming place for everyone, of all abilities.
 - 40. Audio/Video critiques will be uploaded to your account and available for viewing in the WE Developments app.
